## ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), passed in 1987, requires all public and private schools to inventory and inspect all buildings for asbestos containing materials. This inspection was completed at Elk Point-Jefferson School in 1988, and has been updated every third year (last re-inspection was conducted July 9, 2013). Any areas of known or assumed friable or non friable asbestos will continue to be inspected on a regular basis (every six months) and procedures implemented to assure no health hazards are present.

Our management plan has been filed with the State Department of Health and is on file in the school office. The plan is available for public inspection during normal office hours. Copies of the management plan will be provided to requesting parties for the cost of the reproduction. Re-inspections will be conducted every third year so long as asbestos is known or assumed to be in the school.
