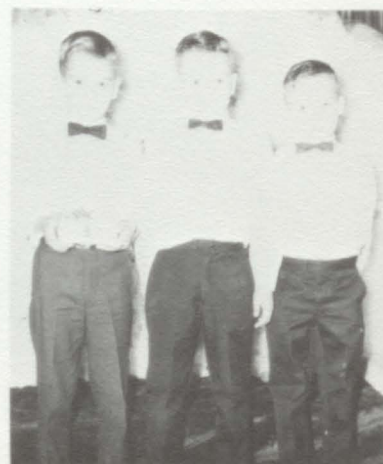
## Attendants for 1967

## Seniors Present "Poor David"

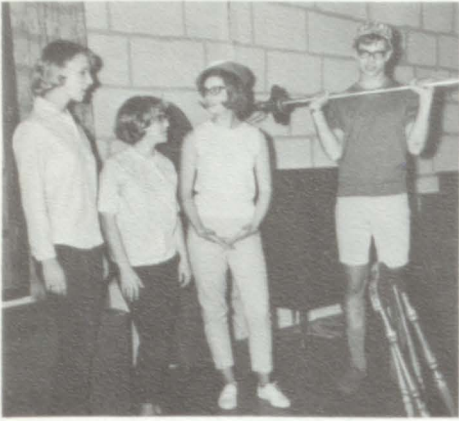
