
The mile relay team of Weaver, Rosenbaum, Slattery, and Abraham set a new school record in the time of 3:32.9 at the Beresford Invitational. They also placed second in the State Track Meet.



Rosenbaum, Noble, Weaver, and Abraham made up the sprint-medley and the 880-yard relays. They lowered the school record in the medley to 3:41.8 in the State Track Meet and the 880-yard relay record to :35.8 in the Beresford Invitational.



The thinclads from Elk Point had a very successful season this year. Terry Weaver, who was selected most valuable, led his teammates to third place in the State Track Meet. 
