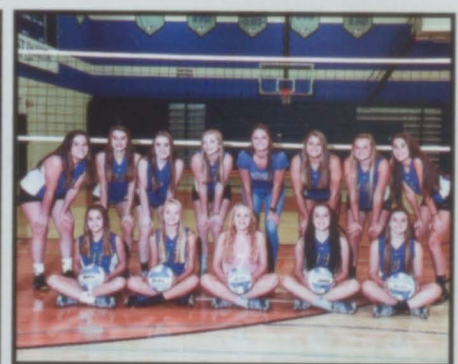
C TEAM & JR. VARSITY

Both the JV and C volleyball teams had very successful seasons this year. The two teams had fun and made memories that will last a lifetime.

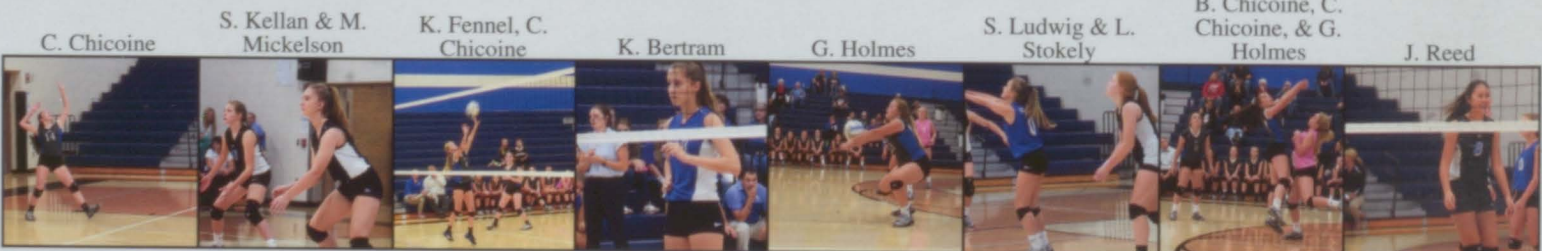
